### Academic All-rounders Shine in National Competitions

**Roseville College students are among the country's brightest "all-rounders" after scoring consistently high marks in national competitions across a range of subjects including Mathematics, Languages, Geography, English and Science.**

With some results still expected, Year 10 student, Rachel Woodhouse, who recently won the NSW Young Scientist Awards' Environmental Science Prize, has received three High Distinctions in the National Languages Test in French, the ICAS Mathematics Competition and the National Geographic Channel Australian Geography Competition, and two Distinctions in the ICAS English Competition and the Westpac Australian Mathematics Competition. Fellow Year 10 student, Katherine Quail, has secured High Distinctions in the National Languages Test in Japanese and the ICAS Mathematics Competition, with Distinctions in the ICAS English Competition and the Westpac Australian Mathematics Competition.

Year 9 student, Gloria Giang, has also received three High Distinctions in the National Languages Test in Japanese, the Westpac Australian Mathematics Competition and the ICAS Mathematics Competition, as well as Distinction awards in the National Geographic Channel Australian Geography Competition and the ICAS English Competition.

Roseville College values participation in such national competitions which provide students with an opportunity to experience examination conditions and test themselves against national benchmarks.
