

2010 Schedule of Fees and Charges

Enrolment Fees

Application Fee \$220 (Incl. GST)	(Non refundable) to be sent with Application.
Acceptance Fee \$1000	(Non refundable) is required to confirm when the College offers a place.
Bond of \$1500	Payable 18 months prior to commencement at the College. Provided that the student commences her studies at Roseville College in the year offered, and completes Senior School at the College, then the Bond will be refunded without interest when all accounts are settled.
	These fees are payable per student and are not credited towards School fees.

If applicable, all fees and charges are inclusive of GST.

Extra Charges

Extra charges will apply for girls studying practical subjects such as Design and Technology, Photography, Textiles and Design and Visual Arts in the Senior School. Additional charges will also be made for camps, special presentations and programs, excursions, elective sports and textbooks supplied by the College.

Extra Subjects

A wide selection of optional extra subjects in cultural and sporting activities is available. A list of these subjects is distributed to all present and new students before the commencement of each year, with details of the individual charges per semester. In some cases the College acts as a facilitator only for the various contractors who provide these services. The contractors will forward invoices to parents and cheques should be returned directly to the contractor.

Concession for Sisters Attending the College at the Same Time

A 10% concession of school fees will be granted to the second and subsequent sisters attending the College at the same time. Students eligible for other concessions such as scholarships or clergy discounts etc. will be able to receive one discount only being equal to the amount of the larger of the concessions.

Payment of Fees and Charges

Fees and charges are due and payable in advance or during the first week of the term to which they relate. There are several options available for the payment of fees and these include:

1. Full payment by cheque at the commencement of each term;
2. BPAY® (including debit or credit card link to bank account);
3. BPOINT® (CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS) Online – visit www.roseville.nsw.edu.au, click on the BPOINT® link option and follow the prompts (a 1% surcharge applies to each transaction). VISA or MASTERCARD accepted only.
4. BPOINT® (CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS) Phone – Call 1300 276 468 and follow the prompts (a 1% surcharge applies to each transaction). VISA or MASTERCARD accepted only.
5. Fortnightly or monthly instalments by direct debit; Instalments can be made from bank accounts or credit cards (a 1% surcharge applies to credit card payments) VISA or MASTERCARD accepted only
6. The entire year's School Fees and Service Charges at the commencement of the year.

Accounts not paid within 30 days may incur an administration charge, unless a specific written settlement arrangement has been made with the College.

If a family considers that they may have difficulty in paying fees in any term they should contact the Business Manager before the fees are due, and make acceptable alternate arrangements for the payment of the fees. The College may accept deferred payment of fees.

Building Fund (ABN 95 574 523 186)

Future development of the College relies to a considerable extent on money raised through voluntary contributions to the Roseville College Foundation Building Fund. Building alterations, minor building projects, major renovations and new buildings are made possible by Building Fund donations, as School Fees are not set to cover all this work. The College encourages all parents to contribute to this fund. The suggested level of donation for 2010 is \$150 per term per family. All donations to the Roseville College Building Fund are **fully tax deductible**.

Withdrawal

A student's enrolment is deemed to be continuous for the span of education years provided by the College. A full College term's notice in writing is required before a girl leaves the College, or a full term's fees will be charged in lieu of this. For example if you wish to withdraw your daughter at the end of Term 4, the Principal must be notified in writing by the end of Term 3.
