# Conditions

1. One bursary, based on academic merit and financial need, is available to a girl currently studying at another school and wishing to attend Roseville College for Years 11 and 12, or Years 10, 11 and 12. A means test will be applied to both Parents/Guardians and will be held confidentially by a committee comprising the Principal and the Business Manager.
2. The Foundation Bursary provides 100% concession in tuition fees and other charges over a period of two (2) or three (3) years provided the work and conduct of the Scholar are thoroughly satisfactory.
3. Each applicant must be in Year 9 or Year 10 currently (2020) or eligible to commence Year 10 or Year 11 in the first year of the duration of this Scholarship.
4. Each applicant should submit copies of her two most recent school reports and a confidential report from the Principal of her current school, if such can be obtained.
5. In addition to completing an Application Form for the Foundation Scholarship applicant should submit an Application for Enrolment together with the required Application Fee and a full copy of her birth certificate.
6. The College has the right to reject any application and is not required to give any reason for such rejection.
7. Applications are invited by advertisement in the press before the closing date.
8. The Foundation Scholarship is awarded after consideration of the applications and reports. An interview with the Principal will be required. The College has absolute discretion to withhold the Scholarship from any applicant and is not required to give any reason for so doing.
9. The College has the right to alter, amend and vary these conditions and to discontinue or suspend the awarding of further bursaries subject to the availability of funds.
10. No student may hold two Roseville College bursaries or scholarships concurrently.
